

Parting forever from a loved person will call back precious memories, memories of what was and what has now passed, memories you cherish. After a dignified farewell at the crematorium the question arises: what to do with the ashes of the deceased?

Often, scattering the ashes on a designed meadow or other place is chosen. But this scattering is short and definitive. After the ceremony, you have no place to seek solace, to express your feelings or to simply share time in silence. Many only realise this after the ash has been scattered.

With the introduction of the Waterurn, you now have the possibility to give these memories a place in your life. The patented urn releases the ash slowly into the earth, invisible and discreetly, while the place is marked by a beautiful bronze urn. We are convinced that this urn will take up a special place in your life.



The Waterurn is a hollow bronze ball with space for the ash of two people and openings that allow rainwater to enter. The urn catches the rainwater, which comes into contact with the ash. With the help of a patented system, the ash is gradually released with the water and absorbed by the earth. It takes an average of ten years until the ash is completely absorbed by the ground.

The patented dispersal system of the Waterurn allows a temporary interruption of the process. This makes it possible to add the ashes of a second deceased into the urn. Moreover, the process can be interrupted to relocate the urn, for instance when you are moving house. The release of the ash from the urn to the ground can be regulated.

The Waterurn is particularly suitable for installation in your own private garden, but it is also suitable for installation on the grounds of a crematorium or cemetery. The Waterurn is available in several shades of patina: black, brown, bronze and green. Because the Waterurn's patina is hand-made, each urn has its own character. This also makes it possible to order a different patina.

The water urn has won the International Funeral Award 2005, the highest award for innovation and creativity.

With the Waterurn, you can deal with your precious memories in a personal way and at your own pace. You can share the grief and the joy. It

will also be reassuring to know that no one will have to decide what to do with the ashes in the future.
